Driving Recycling Demand

DEP Recycling Awards

In the midst of the worst public health emergency in a century, Senator Bob Smith introduced the most potentially significant piece of recycling legislation since the Mandatory Source Separation and Recycling Act in 1987! S2515 would establish recycled content requirements for plastic containers, glass containers, paper carryout bags, reusable carryout bags made of plastic film, and plastic trash bags, and

prohibit the sale of polystyrene “peanuts” packaging. This webinar discussion will focus on a broad range of market development efforts underway in New Jersey along with content legislation proposed or passed elsewhere in the U.S., including AB793 enacted by the California Legislature on August 30th - now pending Governor signature.
