

A word from our new President – Gary Smalley



Just wanted to send a message and tell you a little about myself and my shared vision for the future and success of ANJR.

I was born and raised in South Plainfield and still live there. Graduated in 1975 and married my High School sweetheart in 1980. 2 kids, son, and a daughter, 2 granddaughters and another 1 on the way. Both of my kids live 15 minutes away and I am blessed that they are so close and they still like my wife and me!

My great-grandfather was an original builder and resident of what was called "Mud Island" in Manahawkin, real name is Mallard Island. He was a professional clammer and when I was 16, I got my license to be a professional clammer as well and spent every summer with him until he got too old to jump off the side of the boat. We clamed in the Great South Bay and did the clammers shuffle in 3-4 feet of water. When we felt a clam, we would use the rake to pull them up or lower our heads in the water to pick them up with our hands. Back then I would get 5 cents apiece, average sack had 500 clams in it.

The Smalley family owned a couple of wholesale and retail Seafood stores in Dunellen and Plainfield, appropriately named Smalley's Seafood. Many nights I would drive the pickup truck at 3:00 in the morning into the City (NYC) to Fulton's Fish Market.

In early 1981 I bought into my father-in-law's family-owned garbage company and 2 years later I bought him out 100%. I was on the front lines when the State of NJ introduced Recycling and to honest with you, I never thought it would last. Man was I wrong!

I turned a 1-1/2 per day business to running 12+ routes per day, including 3 roll-offs with over 100 boxes. I'm not including this to boast but rather to provide a level of comfort to our members that I have industry knowledge. Including membership, sponsorship, and support of the following:
